The Beach Cleanup Event this year will be a little different due to COVID-19 protocol.

ADIMS will not be holding a Public Event at the Old School as in past years.

We welcome small family groups/pods to clean up different shoreline locations and, as in past years, remove plastic and debris from the marine environment.

ADIMS will also have a registration table on Sat, Sept 19 and Sat, Sept 26 at the Old School Market where volunteers can register and sign the participant's form. You can choose to clean a specific area of shoreline or join one of our boating, trucking or sorting teams. Volunteers need to provide their own gloves, but ADIMS will have burlap sacks available for collecting debris. You can clean your designated shoreline area any time during the week to suit schedules or tides and drop off at the farm site.

The final sorting event will be held the week of Oct 3rd. Details to be announced later.
ADIMS will work with Ocean Legacy and BCSGA to assist with recycling and transporting.
